How to complete the form and run it

1. Click the “load” button to obtain the current values for all settings..
2. Make changes to any settings desired by typing in new values.
3. Click the “save” button to store the values.
4. When finished with all changes, click the “Exit” button to close the form and return to the main menu.

Notes:

Country code can be selected using the drop down list box. This code determines which holidays are processed.

The “spares” boxes show colors and values which can be used. To use these values copy the color number in the text box on the left (e.g. 0xFFE6BF) to one of the text boxes on the left. The colors on the left affect how the various controls are displayed on each form. For example, the “OK Button” determines the color on the OK button. The color in the criteria text box affects the color shown for the text box used to specify data selection criteria, etc.

Be careful not to specify values that can not be seen. For example black (0x000000) should only be used for text, not for any of the controls, otherwise they cannot be read.

The “reset” button may be used to set the values back to their default settings.
